



CAMPGROUND RULES

EMERGENCIES:

Should you require emergency services **dial 911**

Inform the dispatcher you are at the Husker Harvest Days Visitor Parking lot at the north end.

Rows in the parking lot area are marked with numbered signs mounted high on orange posts – KNOW YOUR ROW!

QUIET TIME:

9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

SAFETY AFTER DARK:

In order to ensure safety after dark, please carry a flashlight. No bike, golf cart, ATV (or similar vehicle) riding after dark.

SPEED LIMIT:

ALL vehicles must abide by a 5 Mile Per Hour speed limit

TRASH:

Please place all garbage in designated dumpsters

CAMPFIRES:

Campfires are NOT permitted

FIREWORKS AND FIREARMS:

Prohibited including BB, Airsoft and pellet guns.

PETS:

Keep on leashes (six-foot maximum length) or inside and do not leave unattended. No excessive barking allowed. Pets must be walked by a responsible person to pick up after them immediately. Pets are not allowed on the Show Field.

CHILDREN:

Guests are responsible for all behavior of children. All children under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
