Policies - Country Lifestyle Tent

Husker Harvest Days is the world's largest totally irrigated farm show. Sponsored by **Nebraska Farmer**, Husker Harvest Days features an 80-acre exhibit area displaying over 600 manufacturers and suppliers of the newest farm products and services. Other attractions include daily field and livestock handling demonstrations, Ride 'N Drives, Health Screening, and Country Lifestyle Tent.

Show Dates:	September 12, 13, and 14, 2023
Show Hours:	Tuesday & Wednesday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Thursday (<u>only</u>) 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Location:	Six miles west of Grand Island, Nebraska on Husker Highway. Physical address: 9000 West Husker Hwy, Wood River, NE 68883
Booth Size:	10 feet (frontage) x 8 feet (depth) per booth. Limit three booths per exhibitor. Exhibits will be displayed inside large metal-framed tent.
Booth Fee:	\$300.00 per handcrafted booth. \$600 per commercial booth. (2) exhibitor passes provided free with each booth. No cancellation refund after July 1, 2023.
Eligibility:	Handcrafted arts, crafts, and commercial booths available. All exhibitors must have a Tax I.D. Number and Nebraska sales tax permit. For information to obtain go to www.revenue.ne.gov .
Setup:	Exhibit setup is Monday, September 11, 2023. Exhibits must be in place by 6:00 p.m. Exhibitors are responsible for their own tables, chairs, shelving.
Electricity:	Electrical hookups are available (with advance request) at a cost of \$70.00. Exhibitors must supply their own 100' extension cords.
Security:	Security personnel will be on duty evening and night hours, Monday through Wednesday. Husker Harvest Days/Farm Progress is not responsible for losses due to theft, vandalism, or other causes.
Exhibit Restrictions:	Exhibitors must comply with the following policies and insurance code restrictions: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.) No open burning (candles, etc.) permitted inside exhibit tent or show grounds.2.) No electrical commercial power tools within the exhibit tent.3.) No parking on the exhibit field during show hours.4.) Products can not contain the words Husker Harvest Days, Farm Progress, or Nebraska Farmer which are registered trademarks.5.) No smoking/vaping inside of tent.
Servicing your Exhibit:	You are permitted to drive in to service your booth before and after show hours. All vehicles must be off the exhibit field by 7:45 each morning of the show. Servicing after show hours enter exhibit area after 5:30 p.m.
Teardown:	Exhibit teardown may not begin before 4:00 p.m. of the last day of show. Exhibitors are responsible for removal and cleanup of their exhibit. Do not remove your display before that time.
Parking:	Vehicle/trailer parking located at east side of show office. Enter at the north end of show office. Self-contained campers and RV's park in the northeast corner of the East Visitors Parking Lot.
