HOW DO I PURCHASE TICKETS TO HUSKER HARVEST DAYS?

Tickets can be purchased online at www.HuskerHarvestDays.com or onsite at the show gates. Student tickets can only be purchased at the gates and must present a valid student ID. Tickets will be available at www.HuskerHarvestDays.com at the end of July 2023.

WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT DO YOU ACCEPT FOR ADMISSION?

The Farm Progress Show accepts credit cards, checks and cash at the gate.

CAN I RENT A GOLF CART?

You can reserve a golf cart in advance of the show. There will be a limited amount of golf carts available on show site and are rented on a first come first served basis. The golf cart company contact information will be available beginning June 1, 2023 at www.HuskerHarvestDays.com.

CAN I BRING MY OWN GOLF CART?

Husker Harvest Days does allow visitors to bring in their own golf carts, but they must purchase a permit from the golf cart provider on the day they visit the show. Permits are free for those who are disabled and bringing their own carts, but proof of disability is required. Husker Harvest Days DOES NOT allow vehicles that idle on their own such as ATV's, "Gators", side by sides, lawn mowers, etc.

IS PARKING FREE?

Yes! Parking is Free. Parking for all vehicles is located adjacent to the show site and is identified by different colored row markers. Remember the row number where you park so you can find your vehicle after the show.

WILL THERE BE HANDICAPPED PARKING AVAILABLE?

There is handicapped parking available. Sites are located close to the entrance gates in the west and south parking lots. Parking staff will direct handicapped vehicles of the correct places to park. Please have your handicapped verification visible.

IF I PLAN ON CAMPING, WHERE CAN I PARK?

RV and camper parking are available at Husker Harvest Days, east of the show grounds. There is no fee to park and no facilities are provided. The grounds open to camper and RV parking after noon (12:00pm) on Monday, September 11, 2023.

WHAT FOOD IS AVAILABLE ON SITE?

There will be four food courts located in each quadrant of the grounds. Food courts will offer a variety of items such as hamburgers, chips, hot dogs, BBQ sandwiches, ice cream, ribeye steak sandwiches, water, coffee, milk, and soda pop. In each food court there is also a restroom facility.

CAN I BRING MY OWN FOOD AND DRINKS TO HUSKER HARVEST DAYS?

Visitors can bring their own coolers to the show. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.

CAN I BRING MY DOG TO THE FARM PROGRESS SHOW?

No pets allowed except service animals which must always be leashed.

WILL HUSKER HARVEST DAYS BE CANCELLED IF IT RAINS?

Husker Harvest Days will be held rain or shine. In the case of extreme weather, the show may be closed or delayed depending on the severity of the weather.

IS THERE AN ATM ON-SITE?

Yes, an ATM will be located at the intersection at Main Street and Central Avenue.

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE ON SITE?

First aid stations are located at the Northeast corner of the grounds. There are also complimentary services available in the Health and Safety Tent including blood pressure testing and diabetes screenings.

LOST AND FOUND

All Lost and Found items will be brought to the show office located at the south end of the exhibit field outside of Gate #4.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms are located near the entrances and within the four food court complexes in the center of each quadrant of the exhibit field.

WHERE IS THE NEBRASKA FARMER HOSPITALITY TENT?

Visit with the editors, pick up a copy of the latest Farm Progress publications, enter to win fabulous prizes, visit the health screening booths, or just relax at the Nebraska Farmer Hospitality Tent located at Main Street and Central Avenue.

INFORMATION BOOTHS

There are five information booths dispersed throughout the grounds. These will be stocked with show information as well as local materials. Any last-minute changes, exhibitor additions, or special program details can also be found at the Info Booths. Information Booths are distinguished on the map by a question mark (?).

WILL THERE BE FIELD DEMONSTRATIONS?

Field Demonstrations are located north and west of the show grounds. Corn Harvesting Demos will be held in two separate sessions at 10:30am & 1:00pm, Tillage will begin immediately following the combining demonstration at 1:00pm, Corn Residue Baling will be at 1:30pm and Haying Demonstrations will be at 2pm.
